Mysterious illness: Over 200 people quarantined in J&K

OVER 200 individuals, who came in contact with the affected families of the 17 people who died due to the mysterious illness in Rajouri, have been quarantined as a precautionary measure, an official said on Thursday. Four people, including three sisters, have been shifted to hospitals, with three airlifted to a hospital in Jammu. Top health officials have identified a common factor among all those who lost their lives in

Badhaal village as involvement of the brain and damage to the nervous system. National Conference (NC) leader and local MLA Javid Iqbal Choudhary on Thursday demanded the imposition of a medical emergency to save people and contain the spread of such a mysterious illness. Over 200 individuals who came into contact with the affected families have been relocated to a quarantine centre set up in the building of nursing college and GMC hospital in Rajouri, they

said. A new quarantine centre was set up in nursing college on Wednesday. As a precautionary measure, these relocated individuals include close relatives of the deceased. Several individuals who had contact with the affected families, from those who took children to the hospital to those who participated in burials, have also been identified. These individuals have been moved away from the village as a precaution to break the chain, officials said. Strict security measures have been implemented at the quarantine centre located in the nursing college building in Rajouri, designated specifically for quarantine purposes. The facility has been secured with fencing and rigorous monitoring, they said. Before admission to the centre, all individuals are being screened. Arrangements have been made to accommodate those affected at the nursing college at Gujjar Mandi. "Keeping in view seriousness, the government should declare Medical emergency to save the population", the MLA told reporters here.

(Contd from page 1) of dead persons is 12 as the torso and body are of the same deceased (female) identified by her son," he said. The official said all bodies have been identified and they were being handed over to their respective families. A team of five senior railway officials has initiated an inquiry into the train accident, the Railway Board said on Thursday. Of those who lost their lives on the tracks, seven hailed from Nepal. Lachchiram Khataru Pasi was among those seven persons. His family not only had to bear the grief of his death but also go through the extremely traumatic process of identifying him from mutilated body parts. Pasi's companions, who survived the tragedy, narrated how they remained huddled in the cramped space between

the two trains to save themselves. Earlier, four Nepalese victims were identified as Kamala Navin Bhandari (43) (who lived in Colaba in Mumbai), Javakala Bhate (60) (who resided at Bhiwandi in Thane), Lachchiram Khataru Pasi (40) and Intiyaz Ali (11), as per a list provided by authorities. Pasi's nephew Ramrang Pasi, who lives in Jalgaon, said his uncle hailed from Narainapur in Nepal's Banke district and was in his 50s. "Some portions of his hands and legs are missing," Ramrang told PTI. He said his uncle was travelling on the Pushpak Express to Thane from Nepal via Lucknow with five others, all daily wagers. Barring Pasi, the others survived, he said. They identified his uncle from his face and clothes, but the sight was so scary that their minds went

blank for a moment, Ramrang said. They wanted to take his uncle's mortal remains to his native place in the Himalayan country, he added. Recounting the horror, Shaukat Ali, a worker from Nepal who was travelling with Lachchiram, said, "A fire rumour spread on the train. We saw smoke inside the bogie. When the train slowed, we hastily stepped down and the train got empty." As they got off, another train moving in the opposite direction approached within a couple of minutes. Before they could comprehend what was happening, everyone started running helter-skelter to save their lives while there was no place to escape, he said. "We found a small space between the two trains and we laid down there, tightly holding each other, hence we survived," Ali said.

With 35 fresh cases, Guillain-Barré syndrome cases in Pune rise to 59

■ GBS is a rare condition that causes sudden numbness and muscle weakness, with symptoms like severe weakness in the limbs. State Health Department formed a Rapid Response Team to investigate the sudden rise in this disease. PUNE, Jan 23 (PTI) PUNE on Wednesday reported 35 suspected fresh cases of Guillain-Barré syndrome (GBS), an immunological nerve disorder, taking the count to 59, officials said. Doctors said that GBS is a rare condition that causes sudden numbness and muscle weakness, with symptoms like severe weakness in the limbs. "The total number of GBS cases increased to 59 on Wednesday including 38 men and 21 women. 12 patients are currently on ventilator support," said a health official. The State Health Department formed a Rapid Response Team

(RRT) team to investigate the sudden rise in this disease. Dr Babasaheb Tandale, a scientist from the National Institute of Virology (NIV), Dr Premchand Kambale, Joint Director of Health Services, Dr Rajesh Karyekarte, HOD of the Department of Microbiology of B J Medical College, Dr Bhalchandra Pradhan, state epidemiologist and others are part of the RRT. Most suspected patients are within the age group of 30 years. "RRT members visited the affected areas where a majority of these cases were reported and instructed surveillance in Pune city and rural areas. Samples of stool and blood of patients have been sent to NIV. The samples of water from the affected areas are being investigated," said the official. Doctors explained that bacterial and viral infections generally lead to GBS as they weaken patients' immunity. "It is prevalent in both paediatric and young-age groups. However, GBS will not lead to an epidemic or pandemic," said the official adding that with treatment, most people recover fully from the condition.

(Contd from page 1) which comes under the Union Home Ministry, following a Madhya Pradesh High Court order of December 13, 2024 on the issue. Saif Ali Khan's mother and noted actress Sharmila Tagore (Pataudi) and others had challenged in the HC the order dated February 24, 2015, of the Custodian of Enemy Property for India that termed the property of Bhopal Nawab as "Enemy Property". The authority under the Home Ministry had given its ruling on the ground that Nawab Muhammad Hamidullah Khan's eldest daughter Abida Sultan Begum migrated to Pakistan following the Partition. Therefore, all such properties that she was supposed to succeed are enemy properties and vest in the Custodian of Enemy Property for India. However, senior advocate and expert on merger of Nawab properties, Jagdish Chhavani, quoted an order dated January 10, 1962 that after the death of Hamidullah Khan in 1960, the Government of India recognised Sajida Sultan Begum "as such ruler, is the sole successor to all private properties, movable and immovable, held by Nawab Hamidullah. And the GoI have no objection to such properties being transferred to Sajida Sultan Begum." Sajida Sultan Begum is the second daughter of Nawab Hamidullah and as the eldest daughter (Abida) migrated to Pakistan, Sajida became the owner of all such properties, he told PTI.
